**On the revised paper:**

We already commented on the activities and made a number of concrete suggestions. The revised paper did not take these into account, but we still feel that (1) Integrating a qualitative research component in the approach and methodology and (2) supporting community participation and civil society engagement are two priority activities, for which not much is planned.

( On p. 4, there is a mention of the need to link EMIS and survey data with qualitative data, but there is nothing planned for this in the program of activities. On. P. 10, there is a mention of in-country consultations with key stakeholders including communities and civil society organisations, but it stops there.)

Our suggestion is to integrate these two areas of activities under activity 1 (Data) and 2 (Policy) and add the specific details in the proposed approach.

**On the Foreword:**

We believe that note #8, p. vi, under "various bilateral agencies" does not reflect CIDA's contribution and we would kindly ask you to review it, reflecting the comments we made.
